

Hartley Wintney u3a Membership Fee Policy

Full HWu3a membership from September 2023 is £15 per person per year and continues to be subject to possible revision at each AGM. From September 2024 the membership fee will change to £17 per person per year. Full membership, when paid up and subject to the publicised terms and conditions membership, entitles members to:

- Attend as many HWu3a group activities as they wish, subject to availability and payment of any group specific fees that may apply
- Insurance cover via 3AT as applicable for the activity involved; this includes cover for activities with other u3as
- Attend HWu3a monthly meetings, currently at nil charge
- Attend and vote at the HWu3a Annual General Meeting (AGM) – normally 1st Tuesday of November
- Attend and vote at any HWu3a Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM) that may be called
- Access to the password protected “Members Only” element of the HWu3a website
- Receive copies of material distributed via our Membership Secretary which includes:
 - ✓ Notices of forthcoming group activities
 - ✓ Notes from the monthly meetings and AGM/EGM as produced by the HWu3a Secretary
 - ✓ Highlights of Third Age Trust organized activities
 - ✓ Copies of the HWu3a Newsletter
- Receive a copy of the “Third Age Matters” quarterly magazine, assuming that the appropriate consent box has been ticked on the membership application form. For the avoidance of doubt; there is no reduction of membership fee if a member chooses not to receive the Third Age Matters magazine.

Paid-up members of other u3as will be welcome at HWu3a group activities at zero membership fee. Any group specific fees will apply at the same rate as full HWu3a members. Those opting for the zero-rate category agree to the following:

- They will not be entitled to the privileges set out above
- Full paid-up members of HWu3a will have priority where groups are at or near fully subscribed capacity
- The 3AT arranged insurance will be provided via membership of another u3a and therefore it will be essential that a valid paid-up home u3a membership card is presented to the Hartley Wintney group leader for checking
- Copies of the Third Age Matters magazine will be provided via the home u3a
- For the avoidance of doubt; those people attending group activities under the zero-rate category will not be on the HW Beason system for the distribution of HWu3a information

Members of other u3as who opt to become full HWu3a members so that they can partake in the full range of HWu3a activities and to retain the full range of privileges above may wish to not tick the consent box to receive the Third Age Matters magazine via HWu3a and thus avoid having two copies of the magazine.
